The above described Tract of land, Situation Turtle Creek. Including Th<sup>o</sup> Small's Improvement, partly in Plum<sup>b</sup> Township Allegheny<sup>Co</sup> & the residue in North Huntingdon Township Westmoreland County, Containing two hundred seventy three acres two rods eleven p<sup>ts</sup> 1/10 & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
