



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 24th of March 1794 and order of survey received February 26th 1844 surveyed March 28th 1846 to John Craig the above described Tract of land situated in (formerly Upper Smithfield) now Dingman Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County adjoining Philip McKarty, Andrew Bray and Cornelius Cole. Containing Two hundred and fifty acres fourteen perches and allowance of six ft. 6 in. for roads &c.
