



By virtue of a warrant granted to John Gousser dated the 8th day of August 1749, surveyed (according to the old marked trees) the 13th day of June 1793, the above described Tract of Land to Adam Wilhelm, John Heubler and Peter Smith, Situation Tulpehook Township in the County of Berks, Containing one hundred and twenty acres and one hundred and eleven perches, and the allowance of six p. Cent for roads, & at the same time divided the same Land into three tracts (to wit) No. 1. for Adam Wilhelm, Containing sixty four acres and eighty six perches & the All^o of six p. Cent No. 2. for John Heubler Junr. Containing thirty five acres and fifty seven perches & the All^o of six p. Cent, and No. 3. for Peter Smith Containing twenty acres and one hundred and thirty eight perches and the allowance of six p. Cent.
