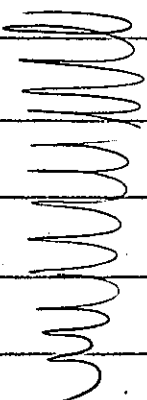


Draft of a tract of land situated in Londondary township, Lebanon County
