



By virtue of a warrant Granted to John Glaser dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August 1795, Surveyed (acc<sup>d</sup> to the Old Marked trees) the thirteenth day of June 1793, for John Hebler Jr., the above described Tract of Land containing thirty five acres and fifty seven perches and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. (it being part of a larger Tract of land formerly surveyed by virtue of the s. c. warrant) situated in Tulpacock in Township in the County of Berks.
