



A Draught of a Lot of Ground Situate adjoining the Center Square on the South side of High Street in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland containing in Breadth Sixty feet and in Length two hundred feet and marked in a General Plan of said Town No 170. Bounded Northward <sup>with</sup> ~~by~~ High Street aforesaid Westward with the Center Square Southward with Lot No 169 & Eastward with Lot No 188. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1772 by Warrant dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 1772 granted to Stephen Duncan.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-fourth day of June 1904.
