



A Draught of a Lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland adjoining the Center Square and marked in a General Plan of said Town No 171. Situate on the North side of High Street and on the East side of the Center Square Containing in Breadth East and West on High Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two Hundred feet, Bounded Southward with High Street aforesaid Westward with the Center Square, Northward with Lot No 172 and Eastward with Lot No 189. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 23<sup>d</sup> day of April 1772 by Warrant dated the 22<sup>d</sup> Instant granted to Joseph Dobson.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-fourth day of June 1904.
