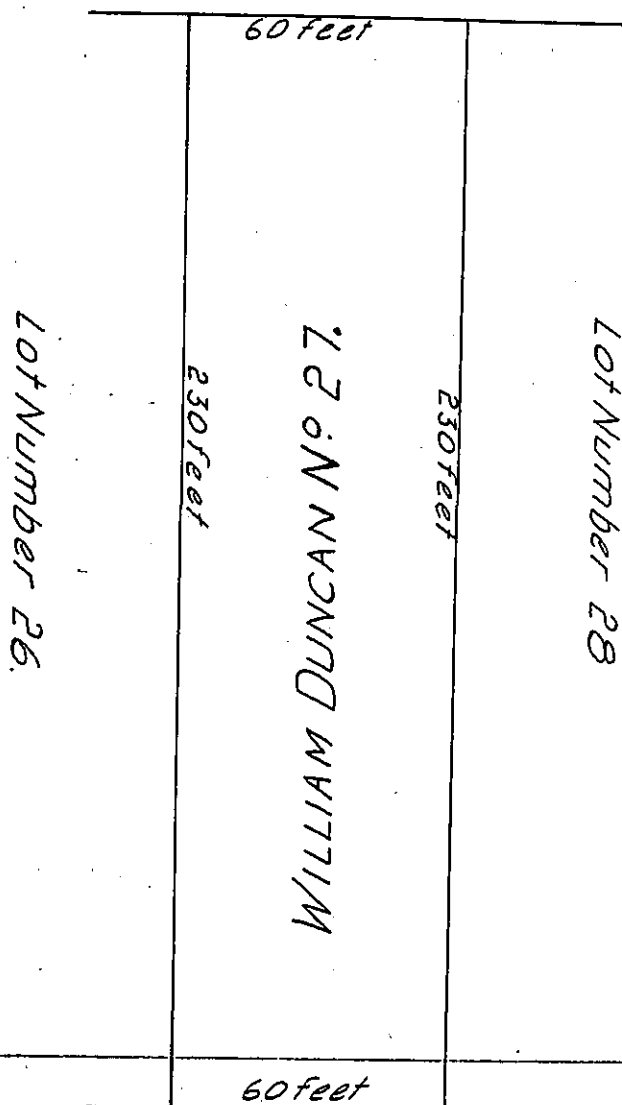


Shamokin Street



Barberry Alley

In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d of July following of a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland for Thomas Brandon marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Twenty Seven, Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Shamokin Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet, Bounded Northward by Shamokin Street aforesaid, Westward by Lot Number Twenty Six, Southward by Barberry Alley and Eastward by Lot Number Twenty Eight. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 30th day of August 1773 for William Duncan by Warrant dated 2^d day of January 1773

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirtieth day of June 1904.
