



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> of July following of a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland for James Gale marked in a General Plan of said Town Numbered Two hundred and Eighty Containing in Breadth on the Broad Way North and South fifty seven feet Six Inches and in Length East and West Two Hundred and thirty feet Bounded Westward by Broadway aforesaid Southward by Billberry Alley Eastward by River Alley, and Northward by Lot Number 279. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 30<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1773 for Margaret Duncan by Warr<sup>t</sup> dated the 2<sup>d</sup> January 1773.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of July 1907.
