



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for James Dill of the County of York of a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumb^d marked in the General Plan of said Town Number Sixty three Containing in Breadth North and South on the East side of Broad Way fifty Seven feet Six Inches, and in Length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Westward by Broad Way aforesaid Northward by Lot Number Sixty two Eastward by River Alley and Southward by Lot Number Sixty four Returned into the Secretarys Office the 10th day of December 1773 for James Dill by Warrant dated the 9th Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of July 1904.
