



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Nineteen Containing in Breadth East and West on the Center Square Sixty feet and in Length North and South One hundred and Seventy feet Bounded Southward by the Center Square aforesaid Eastward by Deer Street Northward by Mulberry Alley & Westward by Lot Number Eighteen Returned into the Secretary's Office the 16th day of December 1774 for James Diemer Esq. by Warrant dated the 9th day of the same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this fourteenth day of July 1904.
