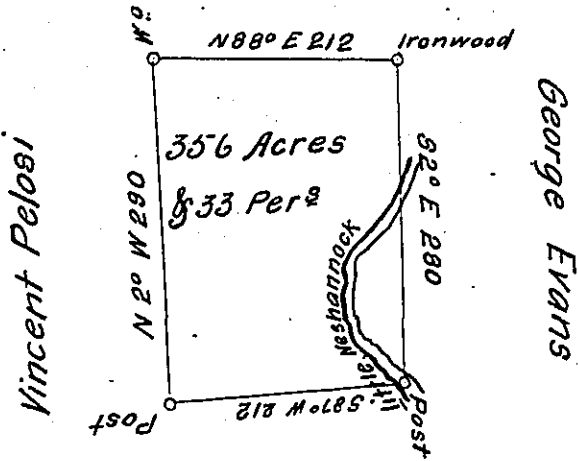

The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1795 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted (obliterated) Evans Esquire dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Aprile 1792 Situate on the little Neshannock branch of Beaver Creek in Allegh<sup>n</sup> (obl) County Called Bush Hill Containing 356 Acres & 33 Perches & Allowance of six per Cent &c.
