



By Virtue of two applications the No 599 dated the 22<sup>d</sup> August 1765 and the other No 3827 dated the 8<sup>th</sup> February 1769 Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> June 1795 to David Muskenunk the above described two tracts of land Situate in Weissenberg Township Northampton County the one containing ninety eight acres and an half and the allowance of 6 P Cent and the other fifty nine acres and the allowance of six P Cent (agreeable to the old lines)
