



Draught of two hundred and fifty acres & sixty seven perches of land with six per Cent for roads situate in Greenwood & Fermanagh Townships in Mifflin County which is part of a survey made 24th Jan^y 1801 & 3^d Jan^y 1806 in pursuance of a warrant for 400^a granted to James Diviny dated 10th February 1801. and said to contain 400^a & 114 Resurveyed and divided on the 10th day of September A.D. 1807. Note, that part of the above draught shown by a dotted line containing 50^a 83 is part of a survey made for Ezekiel King in pursuance of Warrant dated 15th May 1793 and said to contain 413^a & 63. so far J. Devinnay interferes with E. King
