



In pursuance of a Contract with the Members of the Board of property of the state of pennsylvania dated the first of Nov^r 1827 and the Authority therein contained, the above Tract of land was surveyed and calculated by virtue of Appⁿ No 3021 Granted by the Proprietary government to James Elliot the 11th of Ap^r 1769 Containing Two Hundred Ninety nine Acres four perches $\frac{6}{10}$ of allowance of 6 P. Ct. Situate in Pitt Township Allegheny County.
