Containing now excluding interferences one hundred & thirteen acres & fifty four perches with the allowance of six per Cent  $\frac{1}{100}$  Original Survey Contained 414 acres & 34 Pr & all Situate in Nippenose - now Limestone Township Lycoming County & bounded as above
