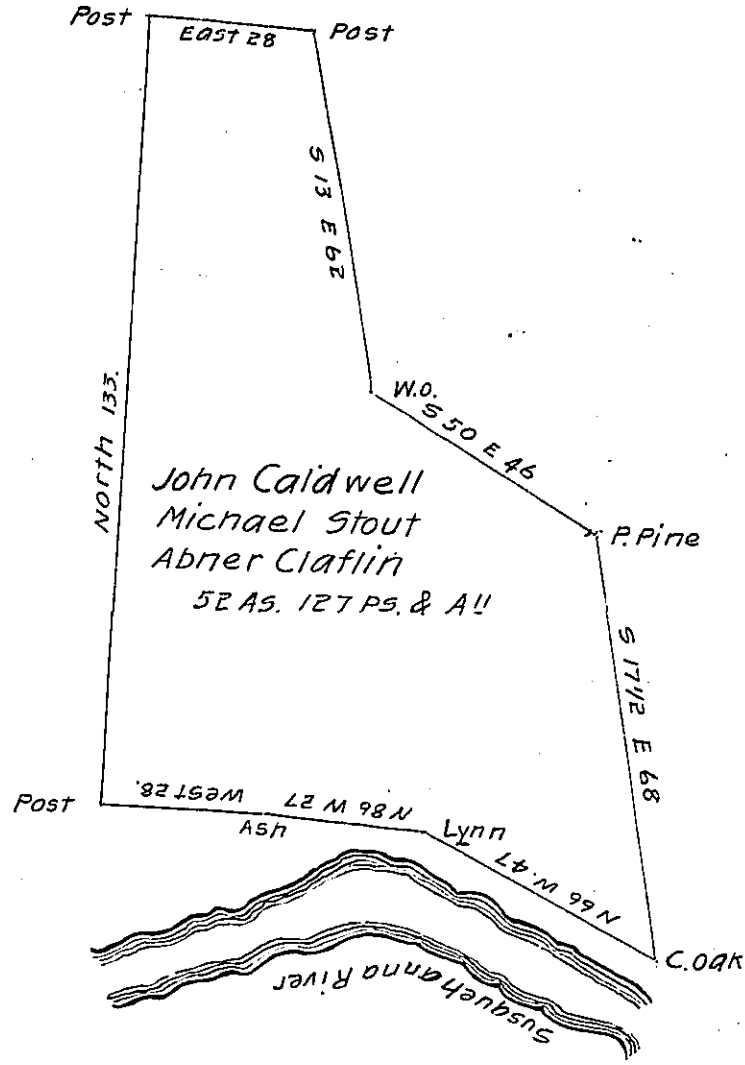


Caldwell & Claflin
