



In pursuance of a Warrant Dated 8th January 1814. Granted to William Corbett was surveyed the 15th day of January 1814. (as appears from warrant and draught of survey filed in the office and the marks on the ground) containing in all four hundred and thirty five acres and ninety six perches and allowance of six per cent situate in (then) Redbank Township (now Clarion) Armstrong County and since that time there has a Patent issued to Isack Corbett for that part in the name of Joseph Halderman. And now to wit on the 27th day of March 1839 was survey'd to Jacob McFaddin that part of the same land including his name and find it to contain three hundred twenty six acres, one hundred and ten perches and allowance of six percent & c. & c. situate in Clarion Township Armstrong County
