



The above is situate in Bullskin township and County of Fayette and was surveyed on the 23rd day of October A.D. 1839 in pursuance of a warrant granted Thomas Crawfoot dated the 4th day of February A.D. 1794 for 400 acres. The above survey contains 432 acres & 64 perches & the allowance of 6 pr Ct. The Improvements are An old furnace for making Iron, not now in use, known by the name of "Breakneck Furnace" two other Settlements, the oldest of which appears to <sup>have</sup> been made 20 or 30 years ago. There is about 20 acres cleared & in cultivation.
