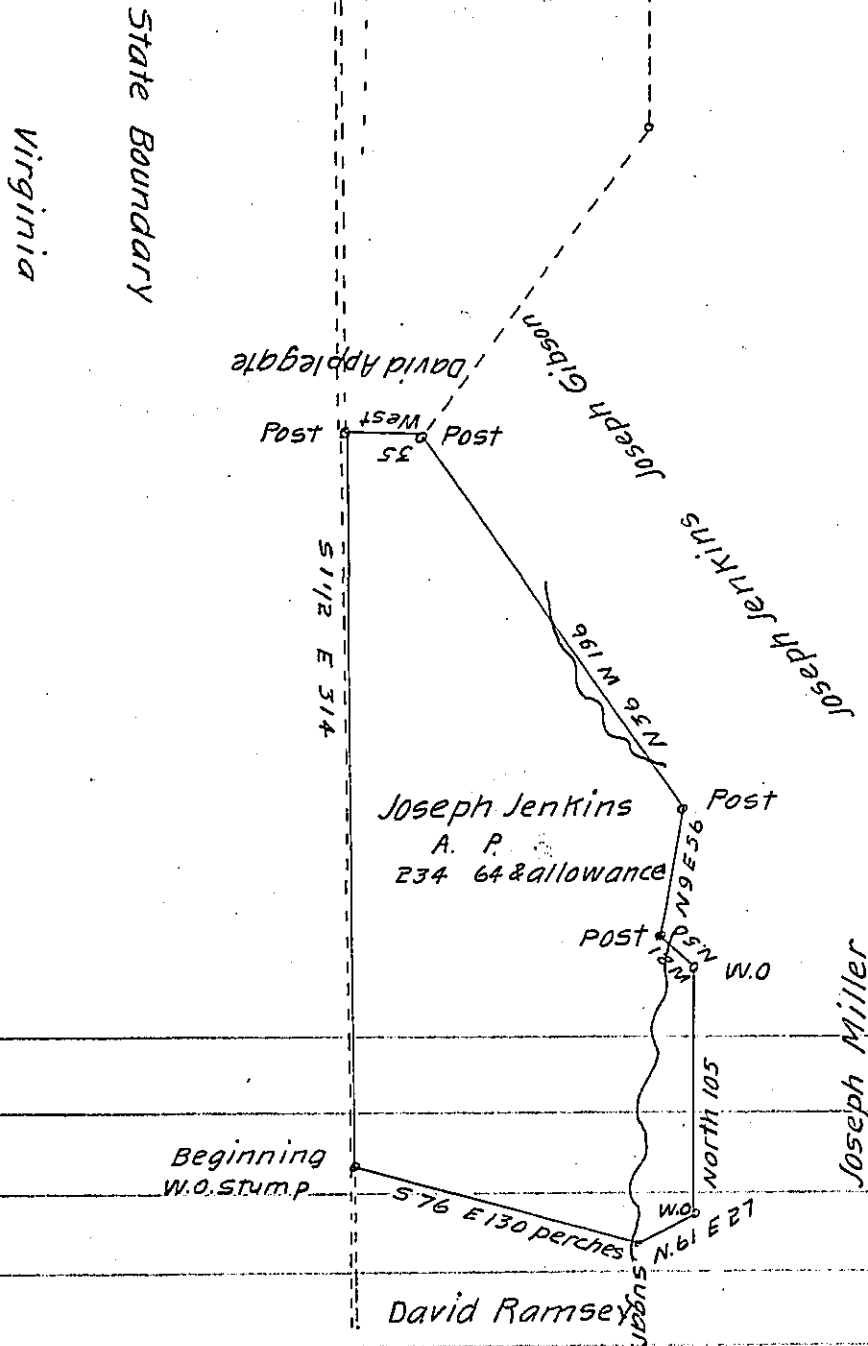

The above Draught, in black lines, represents a Re-Survey of part of a tract of land, by Order of the Board of Property dated January 23rd 1838, being part of a tract of land situate in Hanover Township Beaver County Pa- formerly surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Michael Closs dated May 10th 1802.

The above Re-Survey was made March 12th 1838 in pursuance of the aforesaid Order in favour of Joseph Jenkins' Petition Situate in Hanover Township aforesaid, on the North Branch of Kings Creek. Adjoining lands as above containing 234 acres 64 perches and allowance of six per cent
