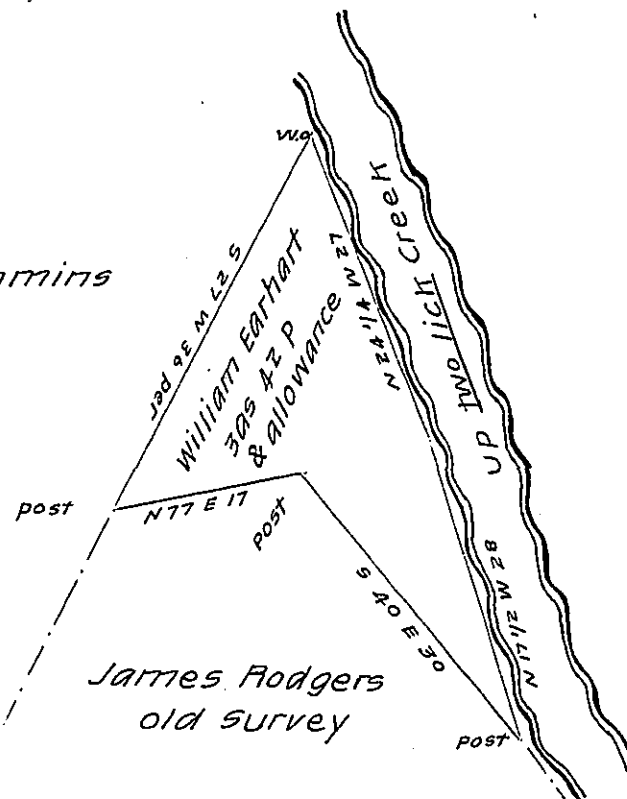


Samuel Cummins
