



The Draught of an Island Called Magee's Island Situate in Bald eagle Creek Bald eagle Township, Centre County Containing thirteen Acres eighty perches Strict measure Surveyed the 26th day of August- 1815 by virtue of a warrant granted to John Devling dated the 26th day of June A.D. 1815

The above described Island is chiefly Cleared and under fence and at the time of making the Survey it was occupied by one Gunsalus, who said that he held it under the Maygee family, and that he had orders to forbid the Surveying of it-
