



In Pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the 30 day of May. A.D. 1792 granted to John Donaldson was surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1817. The above described tract of land containing 388 acres 133 perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c. situated in Bloomfield township, Crawford county, and at the time of making the same James Brian was residing thereon, and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man, and there appeared to be upwards of 12 acres of the land cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, and that the same was divided as above stated, between said Brian & Joseph Clark
