This warrant was executed the 20th June 1810 by Thomas Graham then Deputy Surveyor for Isaac Evans but interfeared with prior warrants on the South west to the amount of 25 to 30^{as} which rendered a resurvey nessesary - the warrant is now Executed agreeable to the Discription & with the consent of the present Owners, as well as of the adjoiners.
