Situate in (formerly Queenhoning Township Bedford County Pa.) now Conneemaugh and Jenner Townships Somerset County Pa. Called Blacks Bottom upon which there are two old Deer Licks. Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1870 in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Black dated the thirteenth day of July in the year 1784
