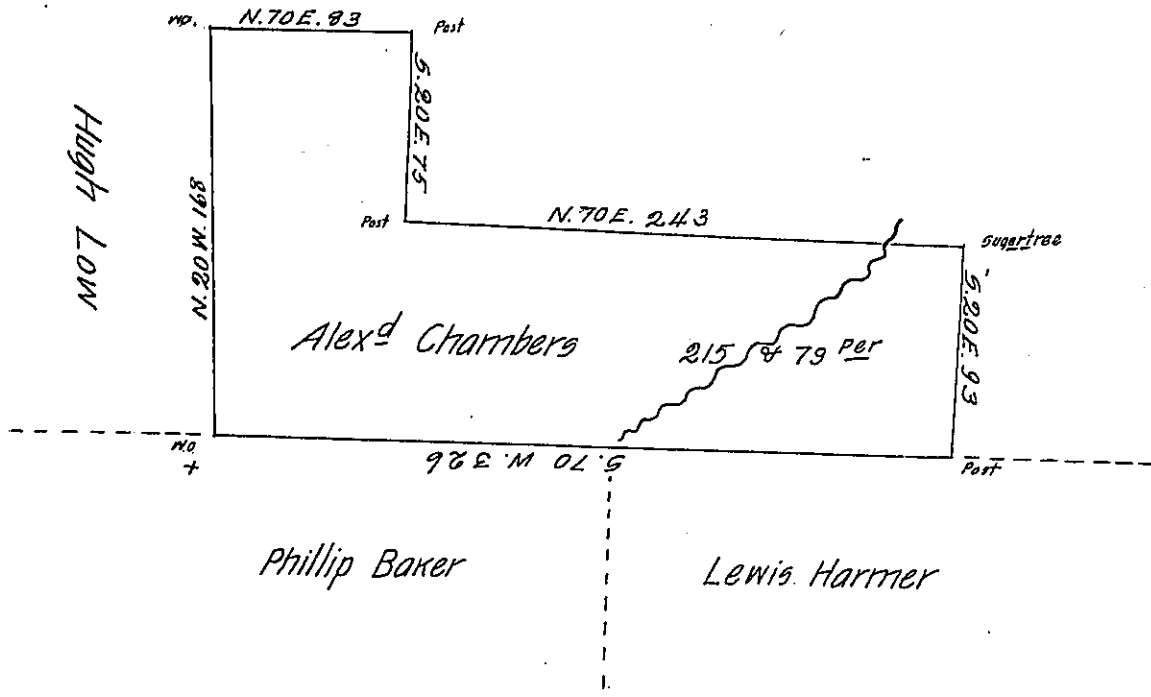


ONE JACOBS SURVEY
