 acres 156 perches & the usual allowance. It being part of <sup>tract of</sup> Land first  
 surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1767. In pursuance of an Order of Survey <sup>2215</sup>  
 granted to Peter Jeston Dated the 22 day of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1766 the whole  
 tract was said to contain three hundred acres & the usual allowance  
 this part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 29<sup>th</sup>  
 day of Oct<sup>r</sup> 1830
