


Note. That small triangular piece above inclosing O, with dotted lines was once a part of the located tract but was afterward surveyed into a tract of Samuel Beagards on a warrant - as it now stands there will be no interferences



The above is a Draft of a tract of Land situated in the Forks of the Monongahela and Youghiogary Rivers in Elizabeth Township Allegheny County which was surveyed in pursuance of an Order of Survey No. 332. granted to John Perry bearing date the 3<sup>rd</sup> of April 1769. said to contain 316 acres but by a resurvey lately made it is found to contain more. Which tract of land has since been divided between Thomas Drennen Sr and Thomas Drennen Junior. The part marked A. inclosed with dotted lines was separated and set apart for Thomas Drennen Junior containing about 154 Acres for which a Patent has been granted to said Drennen. The part marked B. was set apart for Thomas Drennen Sr inclosed with black lines which remain unpatented as yet, but is desirous of obtaining one - which part contains one hundred and eighty three Acres and one hundred and fifty eight perches and Allowance of six pr Ct Resurveyed 7<sup>th</sup> of May 1830 by
