



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 Acres granted to Henry Drinker Esq bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792, was surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November 1831 the above described tract of land, containing 401 acres 150 perches, and allowance of six per Cent for roads &c. situate in Vernon township Crawford county - [Being the same tract which was surveyed on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 1794 for William Dick, in pursuance of his improvement bearing date the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1793.]
