Resurveyed 26<sup>th</sup> May 1829. In pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated 11<sup>th</sup> May 1829 & on a Warrant to Samuel Dryden and Owen Aston bearing date 2<sup>nd</sup> November 1792. Surveyed off the above part for Peter Eberly the 7<sup>th</sup> November 1831.
