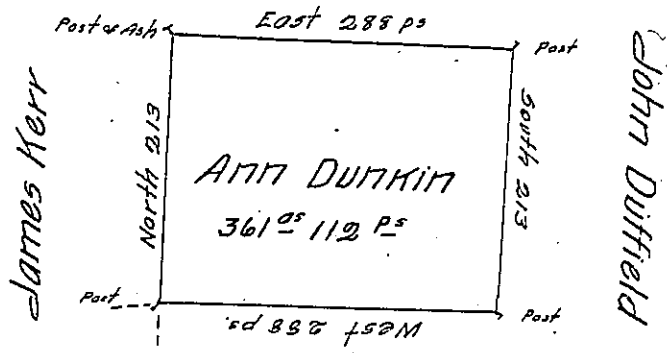

In pursuance of a Warrant of 400 acres. Granted to Ann DUNKIN dated the 30th day of May 1792, was surveyed for Lydia Gardner on the 16th day of February 1830, the above described tract of land containing 361 acres 112 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. and that said Lidia Gardner was residing on the same and there appeared upwards of 20 acres, cleared fenced & in a state of cultivation situate in Sadsbury Township, Crawford County, Pennsylvania.
