



By Virtue of a Warrant dated September 7<sup>th</sup> 1789 surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1793 to Abner Duncan the above tract of Land situate on a Branch of the East Branch of Lackawaxen about ten miles from Delaware River in Northampton County containing four hundred and thirty three acres ~~and~~ and twenty one perches and allowance of six p. Cent for Roads &c.
