



Situate in the forks of Great Meadow Run and Beaver Run in Wharton township Fayette County, and surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> days of June 1833 In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Robert Derry for 400 acres of land dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February 1794

There is about 25<sup>acs</sup> in a state of cultivation, a Grist mill & saw-mill, school house, several cabins and three families residing on this Tract: It has been improved about 12 years
