

Surveyed (for the present owner, William Devers) the above described tract of land on the 20th day of October 1830, containing one hundred and six acres, thirty five perches and the allowance of six perches situate in Kiskiminetas township, Armstrong county, bounded by lands surveyed to Matthew Irwin, John Walker, James Davis Gen't, Samuel Sloan and Samuel Massey, and is the same tract of land for which the warrant granted to said William Devers dated 3^d of June 1833 was intended, and the preceding (if accepted) a return of survey in pursuance of 5^d recited warrant.
