In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Joshua Davis for 50 Acres of land, dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August 1833, there is a small lot of ground cleared, a cabin, a Garden, a Sawmill erected and a family of John Smiths residing on this tract of land; the improvement appears as if it might be two years old.
