



Situate on the Waters of big Sugar Creek in Allegheny County containing 359 Acres 60 perches and allowance of Six p Cent for Roads &c. Resurveyed 12 February 1799. In pursuance of a Warrant of 400<sup>0</sup> granted to Henry Darrock. Bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> May 1792. [It being the same tract of land which was surveyed 21<sup>st</sup> October 1795 for Robert Long in pursuance of his Improvement dated 20<sup>th</sup> October 1795.
