



Situate on the North side of a Branch of Georges  
 Fayette County  
 Creek in Georges township, and surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Feb-  
 ruary 1834. In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of  
 Moses Nixon for six acres of land, dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of  
 January 1834. no improvement on this piece

There is more land imbraced in this survey than is now  
 allowed by law, but as it just takes in all the vacant land  
 laying in that place I think under this circumstance it <sup>would</sup> be  
 proper to accept of it without alteration.
