



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 14<sup>th</sup> day 1794 in  
pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Dailey for 400 Acres of Land  
Dated the tenth day of February 1794 Adjoining William Irvine  
to the West and on the South Side of Said Creek North and West of  
the River Ohio Called Swamp Containing four hundred and thirty  
Six Acres together with the Usual Allowance of Six p<sup>ct</sup> Cent for  
Roads.
