



Situate in Union township Fayette county & is part of a tract of land called "Fouts disappointment" on a branch of Redstone creek in the then New purchase Cumberland county and surveyed the 15th day of September 1769 By order of Survey N^o 3472 dated the 14th day of June 1769 which has been carried down by a chain of titles & c. unto this time. I believe all the other parts are already patented. This part was laid off the 2^d day of November 1811.

N. B. There is about twenty five acres of improved land and a family actually residing thereon.
