



A draft of a tract of land situated in Woodcock Valley Penn township in the County of Huntingdon containing one hundred and sixty six acres 21 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Ludwig and Jacob F Hoover the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1863, being a part of a larger tract of 331 acres 96 perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Dalton dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1762. Re-examined and approved the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 1870
