Being part of a larger tract of 347 1/2 perches which was originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. In Pursuance of a warrant for 200<sup>ac</sup> Granted to John Frankelberger, bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May Anno Domini 1756 Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1780 by Thomas Armor late D.S. under the said George Stevenson late D.S. And now at the request of the present owner Richard Mummert the above has been Calculated, examined &c. who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1810
