



Situate in Manheim Township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 15<sup>acs</sup> & 20<sup>ps</sup> of Allowance &c. Surveyed the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June A.D. 1812 for John Furrey. In pursuance of a Warrant for 13<sup>acs</sup> Granted him bearing date the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1812.

N. B. The improvements on the above described Tract of land at the time of surveying the same were a log dwelling house with a family living in the same &c. And about six or seven acres of winter grain growing thereon rendering it an actual personal resident Settlement, with a manifest intention of making it a place of abode & means of supporting a family
