In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the first day of November A.D. 1784 and the Judgment of the Board of Property dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1785.

Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1816. for and at the request of the present owner Jacob Bowman who has desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
