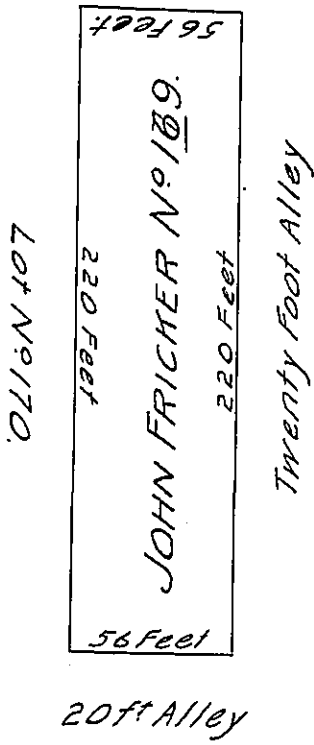


Northampton Street
