We the Commissioners for Adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahela, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that William Fife is intitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Yohogania, Situate on the Waters of Shirtee-to include his improvt made in the year 177-2. also a Right in preemption to one Thousand Acres adjoining thereto. Given under our hands at Cox's Fort the fifth day of February 1780 and in the fourth year of the Common Wealth.
