Draft of a tract of unimproved land situate in Herrick Township Susquehanna County, bounded & described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a post & stones the west corner of a tract in the warrantee name of Jesse Newport, thence by the same North 48° East 122 1/2 perches to a broken down maple, old corner, and North 41 1/2° East 20 3/4 perches to a post & stones corner, thence North 41 1/2° West 11 1/2 perches by land now of H. W. Mumford, to a post & stones corner for the tracts in the warrantee names of Jesse & John Coxe. Thence by the last mentioned track S 48° W 122 1/2 perches to a post & stones the north corner of a tract in the warrantee name of Wm. Fishbeard. Thence by the same S 41 1/2° E 20 perches to the place of beginning. Containing thirteen acres and one hundred & twenty seven perches, and an allowance of six per cent of (or 1/4 of) 100 for strict measure. The courses given being according to the present apparent bearing of the Compass, Surveyed September 11th 1885 for Edw. V. Dimmick in pursuance of a Warrant dated May 27th 1885.
