



A Draught of a tract of land situate on the north side of the West Branch of Susquehanna of posse to the Long Island in the late purchase, surveyed for Thomas Forster on a pre-emption warrant, Dated the Twenty fifth day of October in the year 1785. Containing Two hundred <sup>four</sup> acres of Land & Eighty three perches and allowances of six per cent. &c. with the addition by an Order of the Board of Property to me directed as Reference to the Secretary Office will more fully and at large appear. Given under my hand this ninth day of May 1792
