



The Draft of a Tract of land lying on the head of the Limestone run in Turbutt Township in the County of Northumberland, surveyed on the 14th & 15th days of April, 1794, for Jacob Fulmer by Virtue of a warrant of Resurvey granted to the said Jacob Fulmer & bearing date the third day of December, 1792, and situate agreeably to the above Draft - To wit

- No. 1. The red lines represent the first survey in the name of Cornelius Atkinson & contains 320 acres &c.
- No. 2. Contains 7 acres, a part of the survey in the name of Jacob Fulmer.
- No. 3. Contains 54 acres, and is part of the survey made in the name of Daniel Boone.
- No. 4. Contains 38 acres and is the remainder of Daniel Boone's survey & I believe not Patented
- No. 5. Contains 64 acres & appears to be the land left out of Cornelius Atkinson's Patent &c.
