



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Philip Everhart on a certain lot of ground situate in the Town of Sumbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Three hundred and Three Containing in Breadth East and West on Hurtleberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Northward by Hurtleberry Street acrossaid Eastward by Lot Number Three hundred and Two Southward by Billberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Three Hundred and four. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 9th day of January 1775 for the said Philip Everhart by Warrant dated the 4th day of the same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of September 1904.
