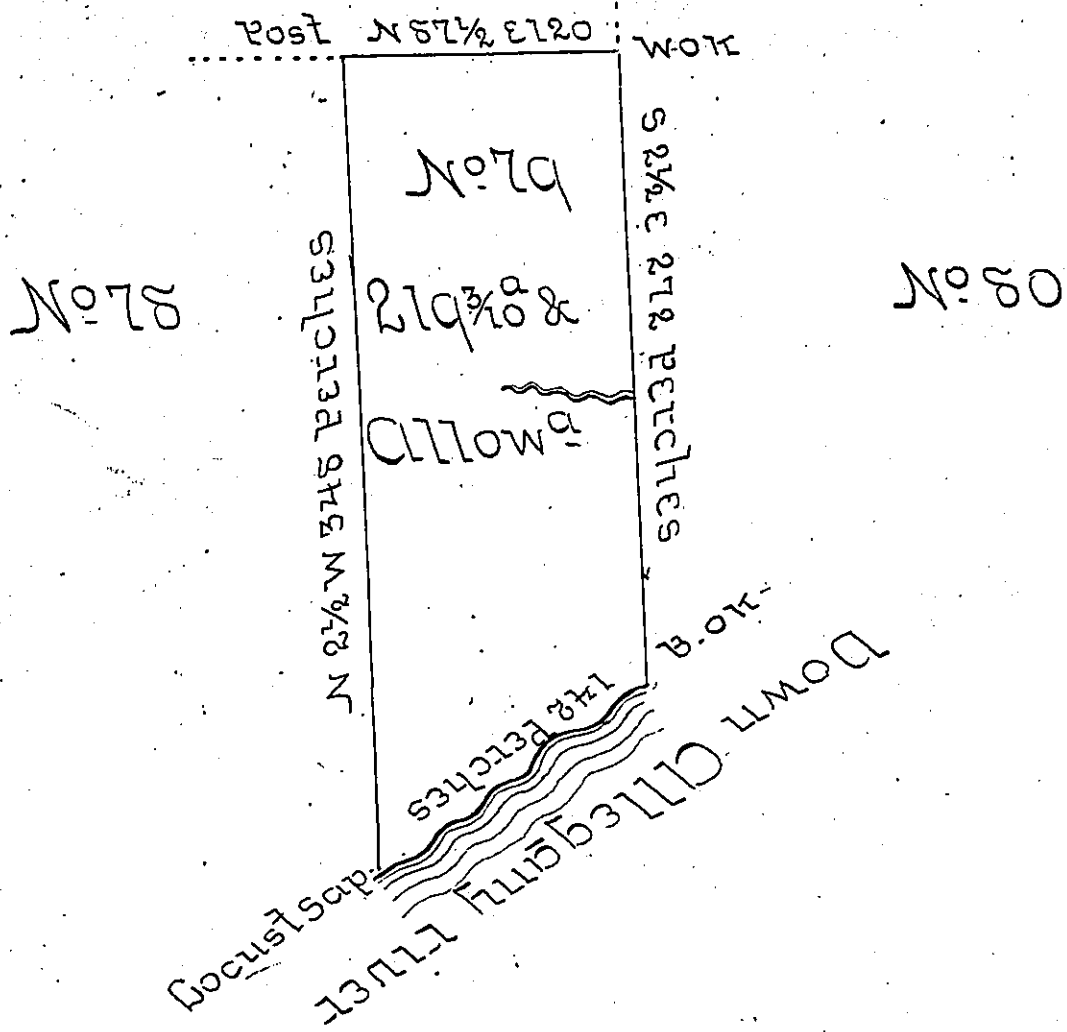

Surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 the above described lot of ground situate on the west side the Allegany River containing Two hundred & nineteen Acres & three tenths of an acre & Allowance of six Percent &c. By Virtue of a Law Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1783 entitled an Act for the Sale of certain Lands for the purpose of redeeming & paying off the Certificates of Depreciation given to the Officers & Soldiers of the Pennsylvania Line &c.
